## Notice of Sanyo Brand Lithium battery business withdrawal

We have completed the business alliance between SANYO and Panasonic Corporation (Panasonic) and completed the transfer of our group's portable Ni-MH battery business (excepting that of Ni-MH batteries used in automobile applications) and Lithium battery business to FDK Corporation (FDK) as of 12<sup>th</sup>/January/2010.
